



ChemCert

Overview

ChemCert is a nationally accredited course delivering competencies in chemical safety and handling. ChemCert is suited to people who are using agricultural and veterinary chemicals as part of their normal work duties as an employee.

Course Outcome

ChemCert, or an equivalent, is required for the issue of a DPIW spray operator Certificate of Competency. Successful completion of this course will satisfy these requirements as well as QA audit requirements. Participants will receive a Statement of Attainment.

Course Content

- Follow basic chemical safety rules
- Apply chemicals under close supervision
- Prepare and apply chemicals
- Transport, handle and store chemicals

Workshop details

Duration: Two days, delivered at Tasmanian Skills Institute campuses state-wide followed by a workplace practical assessment.

Reaccreditation

ChemCert accreditation is valid for **5** years. Participants must undergo reaccreditation within 12 months of certificate expiring. If not renewed within this timeframe participants will be required to complete the two day workshop and workplace assessment at a cost of \$375.

Participants may choose to:

- Undergo a self paced reaccreditation process followed by a workplace assessment or;
- Attend the first day of the two day workshop, complete the theory assessment and undergo a workplace assessment.

Cost

Standard Cost: \$375.00 per person (negotiable cost for group activities).

Reaccreditation: \$250.00 per person
